

VBP webinar: Evidence-based strategies for advancing health equity

The Oregon Health Authority is committed closing health equity gaps over the next decade. Achieving this goal will require applying specific strategies throughout facets of the health delivery system, including value-based payment.

The Transformation Center is bringing in national expert Marshall Chin, MD, to help CCOs and other health system partners apply lessons from care transformation and value-based payment models gleaned from systems throughout the U.S. to aid in reducing health disparities. He'll go over five crucial lessons from his years exploring this topic:

- Designing payment and incentives
- Framing equity as a moral and social justice issue
