

Includes respondents who answered “Yes” to four or more questions (out of eight) about childhood experiences including: 1) emotional abuse, 2) physical abuse, 3) sexual abuse, 4) intimate partner violence, 5) household substance abuse, 6) household mental illness, 7) parental separation or divorce, 8) incarcerated household member.
